DIRECTIONS TO THE RANGE:

333 Hardwood Road, Marshfield, MO: GPS Latitude 37.2688628 Longitude 92.884928

From Marshfield From Highway 38 and A (close to the square in Marshfield) take Highway A south 5.4 miles to Hardwood Road.

Turn left on Hardwood Road. Turn into second driveway on the left, follow drive and turn left at the Y. Continue to follow the drive through the gate and turn right to see the range.

From Springfield: Take Highway 60 east to Highway A. Turn left (north) onto Highway A. Continue on Highway A 7 miles to Hardwood Road.

Turn right on Hardwood Road. Turn into second driveway on the left, follow drive and turn left at the Y. Continue to follow the drive through the gate and turn right to see the range.

Note: The first two or three miles on Highway A is Amish country. Expect to encounter horse drawn vehicles on the Highway.

SASS WORLD RECORD STAGE

MISS CHACHING'S SCHOOLHOUSE

Thursday, Friday & Saturday

The Schoolhouse Stage is there to help you shoot your best!

1. As a warm up/practice stage. The Schoolhouse stage will open one hour before the Shooter's Safety Meeting. You can shoot as much as you want, engaging the targets any way you want, in order to warm up for the Main Match.
2. For testing repairs on malfunctioning firearms. During the Main Match, if a mechanical problem occurs, you can bring your gun to the Schoolhouse Stage and test it with live ammunition, and then return to your Posse to continue with the Main Match stages.
3. At any time other than during the Main Match, shooters can try to set a World Record in the category of their choice. We will provide the video equipment and submit the video for verification for you. The World Record target array and scenario:

WORLD RECORD STAGE SCENARIO

Pistol: 10 Rifle: 10 Shotgun: 4+

Weapons Staged: Rifle staged on table, action closed, hammer down on empty chamber. Shotgun staged on table, action open and empty, all shells to come from shooters person. Pistols hammers down on the empty chamber and holstered.

Starting Position: Shooter will start at low surrender (wrists above respective shoulders and visible from behind). Shooter will be positioned at the middle point of the stage, centered behind the table, and will remain in place for the stage run (stand and deliver stage)

At the beep: Sweep the five pistol targets twice in the same direction. Holster as needed. With rifle, engage the rifle targets with two sweeps, both in the same direction. Rifle must go back to table, action open and clear. With shotgun, knock over 4 targets, a minimum of 4 shots must be fired
